The winner receives a cheque for £500.

The two runners up receive the ETC Award or the
ALD sponsored 'Francis Reid Award' and a cheque
for £250 each.

The three successful students will also have their
work displayed on the ALD stand at the PLASA10
trade show at Earls Court.

The submission must highlight the **CREATIVITY** of the project and **IMAGINATION IN THE USE OF LIGHT**, what inspired you, the processes used to create the final design, and how you would approach the project the second time around.

Supporting information in the form of photographs, plans and research material
can also be submitted.

The entries will be judged by a panel of industry professionals.
